Thank you for your inquiry regarding Beach, ND. There are many things to see and do in the Beach area. The lodging that we have in Beach, if you are campers is the Beach RV Park 701-872-6222 or 701-872-4967 to reserve a spot. Or if you need a motel we have The Badlands Westgate Motel 701-872-4521 and Buckboard Inn 701-872-4521 or 1-888-449-3599. There is also Buffalo Gap Guest Ranch, Bar, Steakhouse & Trailhead for the Maah Daah Hey Trail (701-623-4200) at Exit 18 on I-94 which is only 15 minutes from Beach.

If your tummy is hungry we have some good places to eat: LaPlaya Mexican Restaurant, J&J Chinese Café, Subway (inside of Pilot Flying J), The Legion Club (serving food Friday and Saturday evenings 5-9PM), The Backyard Bar, and Hot Stuff Pizza will fill you up. Just 13 miles south of Beach is The Golva Bar in Golva, ND which serves noon lunches and evening meals.

Sip 'n Sew & Flowers To Go has a nice selection of plants and flowers. They also deliver. Sip & Sew is a quilting shop with a variety of coffee and other beverages. They also carry fabrics, thread, patterns, sewing knick knacks and gourmet coffees. Beach Food Center is full service grocery. Forgot your shirts, pants, boots, coats, gloves or even your underwear? Golden Valley Outfitters is the place to find all of these.

If pottery is what you are looking for, Prairie Fire Pottery is the place to stop. Tama Smith is an internationally known potter.

Body Works Massage and Karen's Massage will help you relieve all the stress from your travels. Ladies, we know that you will want your fingers and toes to look great for the summer weather, so stop in at Tips & Toes.

If you are having a bad hair day, Beach has three great beauty salons (Hairlines, M'Lord M'Lady and New Beginnings) plus a real Barber Shop for the gents. For the treasure hunters, Page Two-Resale Shop is the place to go.

If you're a reader, Golden Valley County Library can find what you are looking for. Beach Food Center also has a small selection of paperbacks.

If fuel is getting low, Flying J Travel Plaza and Interstate Cenex both at Exit 1 in Beach, Olson Service Station (featured on Oprah) in Sentinel Butte and Golva Service in Golva will get your tank full and ready to go.

Beach also has a number of city parks to let the little ones run off some excess energy. Beach swimming pool has a winding 65 ft. waterslide, kiddie's mushroom and wading pool. It is open from June to mid-August.

Adventurers can hike Sentinel Butte, the plateau seen from the Interstate. The view from the top is awesome. It is *highly* recommended however, not to take RVs, campers or small cars up the primitive road that leads to the top.

If you are feeling a bit under the weather, Beach Medical Clinic will get you back to feeling like new. If you are out of your prescriptions, Beach Pharmacy will help you out. It was the first tele-pharmacy in the nation.

Only 25 minutes away is Theodore Roosevelt National Park and North Dakota biggest tourist destination of Medora. With many cute shops and World Famous Medora Musical and don't forget about Bully Pulpit 18 hole golf course.
